

# Strong support for horse show

Thanks to the addition of recently renovated stables, the Bathurst Horse Show had the biggest entries in a decade, with 72 riders and 85 horses.

The show, which incorporates dressage, showing and show jumping, is a centrepiece of the Bathurst Agricultural Show and most of the events take place in the main arena.

"These are numbers we haven't seen in almost 10 years," said Bathurst Riding Club chair Nicole Erasmus.

"We were able to achieve this due to the 12 additional stables we managed to renovate over the past year; previously they were not useable."

Due to the overwhelming support for the event, they had to close entries a day early.

Other equestrian highlights were a thrilling demonstration by members of the SA Western Mounted Games Association (SAWMGA), and the much loved fancy dress class, which featured a spaceman and his alien horse, Batman, and 'The Cat in the Hat's' Thing One and Thing Two.

The judges included showing national judge from Gauteng, Helen Gilfillan, and Maree Lamont; show jumping international judge Mike Butcher, from Cape Town; course designer Ryan Sanders, from Gauteng, and Unaffiliated Dressage judge Milly Whitehead, from Gqeberha.

There was strong support from sponsors — from local businesses to the Western Cape.

"We would like to thank all our sponsors who have helped us achieve something very special," said Erasmus.

## NOTICE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION AMENDMENT APPLICATION

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE AUTHORISATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 22 OF THE ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION ACT, ACT 73 OF 1989, TO UNDERTAKE A LISTED ACTIVITY AS SCHEDULED UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE ACT: CONSTRUCTION OF A BULK WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS: DEDEAT REFERENCE NUMBER: EC05/M/113-06.

The Department of Economic Affairs, Environmental and Tourism issued a Record of Decision to Ndlambe Local Municipality for the construction of a Bulk Waste Water Treatment Works on 27 October 2006. The facility is located on Remainder of Farm 190, Freestone Farm, near Nolutkhanyo, Bathurst, Ndlambe Local Municipality.

Ndlambe Local Municipality proposes to undertake the following Amendment (Part 2) to the Record of Decision issued:

- Upgrade the capacity of the waste water treatment works authorised – the proposed upgrade will increase the capacity of the waste water treatment from 0.36Ml/day to 1,05Ml/day. This will entail:
  - An additional area of 0,9 hectares.
  - 3 x New Anaerobic ponds - Total area = 960m<sup>2</sup>; Depth = 4m; Total volume = 2.8Ml.
  - 1 x New Aerobic pond - Total area = 4000m<sup>2</sup>; Depth = 3m; Total volume = 8,6Ml.
  - 1 x New Settling pond (1st secondary pond) - Total area = 180m<sup>2</sup>; Depth = 3.5m; Total volume = 0.4Ml
  - 4 x Sludge drying beds – Total Area 870m<sup>2</sup>
  - A new building that includes a pump station, chlorination room, guard office, and process controller office & laboratory will be constructed.
